The Senate Standing Committee on Education met Wednesday morning to consider five bills. Chair Shelley Mayer, Ranker James Tedisco, and Senators Joseph Addabbo Jr., Samra Brouk, Robert Jackson, John Mannion, Toby Ann Stavisky, Peter Oberacker, Daniel Stec, and Alexis Weik attended.

The following bills were reported to First Reading:

- SB 117 By Kaplan, Anna. Relates to notice by museums of art stolen during the Nazi era in Europe.
- SB 1321 By Helming, Pamela. Authorizes schools to allow fire departments to make a recruitment presentation in a high school.
- 🚯 SB 4243 By Gaughran, James. Establishes the Long Island power plant tax assessment challenge reserve fund.

Stec voted aye without recommendation.

10 SB 6307 By Harckham, Pete. Relates to extending the time period for recovery of energy performance contract costs incurred by school districts.

The following bill was reported and committed to Finance:

SB 3460 By Gaughran, James. Relates to additional apportionment of building aid for certain projects.
